## The Established Heart

Psalm 112 – "Praise the LORD! Blessed is the man who fears the LORD, Who delights greatly in His commandments. <sup>2</sup>His descendants will be mighty on earth; the generation of the upright will be blessed. <sup>3</sup>Wealth and riches will be in his house, and his righteousness endures forever. <sup>4</sup>Unto the upright there arises light in the darkness; he is gracious, and full of compassion, and righteous. <sup>5</sup>A good man deals graciously and lends; he will guide his affairs with discretion. <sup>6</sup>Surely he will never be shaken; the righteous will be in everlasting remembrance. <sup>7</sup>He will not be afraid of evil tidings; his heart is steadfast, trusting in the LORD. <sup>8</sup>His heart is established; he will not be afraid, until he sees his desire upon his enemies. <sup>9</sup>He has dispersed abroad, he has given to the poor; his righteousness endures forever; his horn will be exalted with honor. <sup>10</sup>The wicked will see it and be grieved; he will gnash his teeth and melt away; the desire of the wicked shall perish."

## **Heart**:

- Spirit [II Corinthians 5:17 Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.]
- **Soul** [**Luke 21:19** [**AMP**] By your steadfastness and patient endurance you shall win the true life of your souls.]
- **Body** [I Corinthians 9:27 But I discipline my body and bring it into subjection, lest, when I have preached to others, I myself should become disqualified.]
- Note: we have taught much on the <u>SOUL</u>. (Focusing on the mind)
- Heart:
  - Not just another word for "spirit."
  - Not the same as "soul" either.
  - A combination of spirit & soul; a link between the two.

**Proverbs 4:23** – Keep your heart with all diligence, for out of it spring the issues of life.

• **I.e.,** the boundaries of our life are set by our hearts. It is our gate-keeper.

<u>Matthew 15:18, 19</u> – But those things which proceed out of the mouth come from the heart, and they defile a man. <sup>19</sup>For out of the heart proceed evil thoughts, murders, adulteries, fornications, thefts, false witness, blasphemies.

• Bad things can be in the heart. If they are, they'll come out!

Back to Psalm 112. What makes this man different?

- vs. 7 his heart is steadfast.
- **Steadfast:** to be fixed; to be firmly established; to be directed aright; to be prepared, be settled.
- vs. 8 his heart is established. (different Hebrew word)
- **Established:** to lean or rest upon or against; to support, uphold, sustain.

## What other things do we notice about this man?

- He is righteous. [vs. 2, 3, 4, 6 & 9]
  - **Romans 10:10** For with the heart one believes unto right-eousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.
- **He is not afraid**. [vs. 7 & 8]
  - He doesn't fear bad news because his heart is steadfast, trusting in the Lord.
  - His heart is established, therefore he won't be afraid.
  - □ I John 4:15-19 Whoever confesses that Jesus is the Son of God, God abides in him, and he in God. ¹6And we have known and believed the love that God has for us. God is love, and he who abides in love abides in God, and God in him. ¹7Love has been perfected among us in this: that we may have boldness in the day of judgment; because as He is, so are we in this world. ¹8There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear, because fear involves torment. But he who fears has not been made perfect in love. ¹9We love Him because He first loved us.
- He is trusting in the Lord. [vs. 7]
  - Proverbs 3:5, 6 Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding; <sup>6</sup>In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct your paths.
  - <u>Trust</u> [Imperative] to be confident; to be bold; to be secure.
