#### Church Stats:

**Mark 12:29-31** – Jesus answered him, "The first of all the commandments is: 'Hear, O Israel, <u>the LORD our God</u>, <u>the LORD is one</u>. <sup>30</sup>'And <u>you shall love</u> <u>the LORD your God with all your heart</u>, with <u>all your soul</u>, with <u>all your</u> <u>mind</u>, and <u>with all your strength</u>.' This is the first commandment. <sup>31</sup>"And the second, like it, is this: '<u>You shall love your neighbor as yourself</u>.' <u>There</u> <u>is no other commandment greater than these</u>."

#### Why should we serve?

- Proverbs 3:27 Do not withhold good from those to whom it is due, when it is in the power of your hand to do so.
- Matthew 20:24-28 [NLT] When the ten other disciples heard what James and John had asked, they were indignant. <sup>25</sup> But Jesus called them together and said, "You know that in this world kings are tyrants, and officials lord it over the people beneath them. <sup>26</sup> But among you it should be quite different. Whoever wants to be a leader among you must be your servant, <sup>27</sup> and whoever wants to be first must become your slave. <sup>28</sup> For even I, the Son of Man, came here not to be served but to serve others, and to give my life as a ransom for many."
- Galatians 3:13, 14 [NLT] For you have been called to live in freedom—not freedom to satisfy your sinful nature, but freedom to serve one another in love. <sup>14</sup> For the whole law can be summed up in this one command: "Love your neighbor as yourself."

#### WATER BAPTISM

**Matthew 28:18-20** – And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. <sup>19</sup>"Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, **baptizing** them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup>"teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen.

 "baptizing" - [Not BAPTO - to dip] BAPTIZO is used in a recipe for making pickles and is helpful because it uses both words. Nicander says that in order to make a pickle, the vegetable should first be 'dipped' (BAPTO) into boiling water and then 'baptized' (BAPTIZO) in the vinegar solution. Both verbs concern the immersing of vegetables in a solution. But the first is temporary. The second, produces a permanent change.

**Romans 6:3, 4** [NLT] – Or have you forgotten that <u>when we became Chris</u><u>tians and were baptized to become one with Christ Jesus</u>, <u>we died with</u><u>him</u>? <sup>4</sup> For we died and were buried with Christ by baptism</u>. And just as <u>Christ was raised</u> from the dead by the glorious power of the Father, <u>now</u><u>we also may live new lives</u>.

#### <u>Why is it a requirement</u>?

- Water baptism deals with our identity who we are.
