Know and Believe

Love – AGAPE.

- "the love that God has for us" known from the actions it prompts; not drawn out by any excellence in its objects; Jesus is the perfect expression of love. [Vine's]
- Ephesians 2:4, 5 [AMP] "But God so rich is He in His mercy! Because of and in order to satisfy the great and wonderful and intense love with which He loved us, ⁵ even when we were dead (slain) by [our own] shortcomings and trespasses, He made us alive together in fellowship and in union with Christ; [He gave us the very life of Christ Himself, the same new life with which He quickened Him, for] it is by grace (His favor and mercy which you did not deserve) that you are saved (delivered from judgment and made partakers of Christ's salvation)."

I John 4:16 – And we have known and believed the love that God has for us. God is love, and he who abides in love abides in God, and God in him.

- "we have known" to come to know. AMP adds [by personal observation and experience].
 - o **Note:** many don't know!
- "and believed" to commit oneself faithfully; to have faith directed towards. AMP adds [with deep, consistent faith]
 - o **Richards:** immovable trust.
 - o **Note**: very few believe.

Why would we know but not believe?

• Known and unknown negative images, unhealthy beliefs, destructive cellular memories, and physical issues.

How can we tell if there's a believing problem?

• Self-sabotage.

Romans 7:21-25 – I find then a law, that evil is present with me, the one who wills to do good. ²² For I delight in the law of God according to the inward man. ²³ But I see another law in my members, warring against the law of my mind, and bringing me into captivity to the law of sin which is in my members. ²⁴ O wretched man that I am! Who will deliver me from this body of death? ²⁵ I thank God—through Jesus Christ our Lord!

Prayer: "I pray that all known and unknown negative images, unhealthy beliefs, destructive cellular memories, and all physical issues related to _____ would be found, opened and healed by filling me with the light, life and love of God. I also pray that the effectiveness of this healing be increased by 100 times or more."

Results of knowing & believing: I John 4:17, 18 [AMP] – In this [union and fellowship with Him], love is completed and perfected with us, so that we may have confidence in the day of judgment [with assurance and boldness to face Him]; because as He is, so are we in this world. There is no fear in love [dread does not exist]. But perfect (complete, full-grown) love drives out fear, because fear involves [the expectation of divine] punishment, so the one who is afraid [of God's judgment] is not perfected in love [has not grown into a sufficient understanding of God's love].
