## Hope That Doesn't Disappoint

**Romans** 5:1-5 – Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, <sup>2</sup> through whom also we have access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and rejoice in **hope** of the glory of God. <sup>3</sup> And not only that, but we also glory in **tribulations**, knowing that tribulation produces perseverance; <sup>4</sup> and **perseverance**, **character**; and **char***acter*, **hope**. <sup>5</sup> Now **hope does not disappoint**, because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to us.

- "<u>tribulations</u>" THLIPSIS; pressure; spiritual bench pressing.
- "perseverance" HUPOMONE; in the NT the characteristic of a man who is not swerved from his deliberate purpose and his loyalty to faith and piety by even the greatest trials and sufferings. [Strong's]
- "<u>character</u>" DOKIME; a tried and proved character.
- "hope" ELPIS; confident, joyful expectation; the happy anticipation of good; always believe you can.
- "disappoint" KATAISCHYNO; one is said to be put to shame who suffers a repulse, or whom some hope has deceived.

## **<u>Hebrews 11:1</u>** – Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

- "faith" PISTIS; fully convinced persuaded immoveable
  because we have proof evidence. [the Word]
- "substance" HUPOSTASIS; foundation; a standing under, support; that which has real existence. [AMP "the assurance (the confirmation, the title-deed)"]
- "<u>things</u>" that are already accomplished.
- "*not seen*" they're real but invisible.

• **AMP**: Now faith is the assurance (the confirmation, the titledeed) of the things [we] hope for, being the proof of things [we] do not see and the conviction of their reality – faith perceiving as real fact what is not revealed to the senses.

## <mark>Both faith & hope are required</mark>.

- Faith without hope = a sailboat without wind.
- Romans 15:13 Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit. [to put confidence in someone]

**Proverbs 13:12** – Hope deferred makes the heart sick, but when the desire comes, it is a tree of life.

- "<u>hope</u>" same as NT, expectation.
- "<u>deferred</u>" prolonged; delayed.
- "heart" linking soul & spirit.
- "<u>sick</u>" wounded, grieving, weak, tired.

## What makes hope delayed?

- Doubt & unbelief.
- Never truly convinced persuaded immoveable.
- Heart problems.
- No real expectation.
- Waiting for God to do something.
- Thinking we're not qualified.
- Not understanding God's will.

**I Peter 3:13-16 [NASB]** – Who is there to harm you if you prove zealous for what is good? <sup>14</sup> But even if you should suffer for the sake of righteousness, you are blessed. And do not fear their intimidation, and do not be troubled, <sup>15</sup> but sanctify Christ as Lord in your hearts, <u>always being ready to make a defense to everyone who asks you to give an account for the **hope** that is in you, yet with gentleness and reverence; <sup>16</sup> and keep a good</u>

conscience so that in the thing in which you are slandered, those who revile your good behavior in Christ will be put to shame.
